The purpose of this modification is to: (1) provide incremental funding pursuant to the Limitation of Funds clause; (2) revise Statement of Work to increase the Program Security Managers hours not to exceed 40 hours weekly. The foregoing action is further implemented by the inclusion of the following changes:

1. Clause 1. FIRM FIXED PRICE, Paragraph B on Page 5 (Mod 29), is revised as delineated on the revised Page 5 (Mod 30), in order to reflect an increase of hours for the Program Security Manager (Michoud) in 7.7.2 of the Performance Work Statement. Option No. 4 is increased by \$46,750 (from \$5,526,984 to \$5,573,734).

2. Clause 2., entitled "LIMITATION OF FUNDS", Paragraphs (a) on Page 5 (Mod. 29) is revised, as reflected on the revised Page 5 (Mod. 30), in order to delineate the sum presently available for payment (\$19,055,249), date and amount for the schedule for allotment of funds (November 15, 2005 \$4,079,251), and the date in which the funds presently allotted will cover the work to be performed (November 15, 2005).

3. Page 12a (Mod 29), Statement of Work (SOW) is revised as delineated on the revised page 12a (Mod 30), in order to increase the Program Security Manager weekly hours 7.7.2 under Section 7.7 Program Security.

4. As a result of the foregoing changes, the following pages are deleted and the corresponding pages are substituted/added. Changes are noted by a vertical line in the right column.

In addition to the Program Security and System Security Engineering effort already identified, Program Security effort shall be required for dedicated support to specific programs, such as the Next Generation Launch Technology (NGLT) program (formerly known as the Advance Space Transportation Program (ASTP), Orbital Space Plane Program (OSP) and the follow-on CEV Program. Provide Program Security support to the Center Special Security Office (SSO) in the area of Sensitive Compartmented Information Facility (SCIF) management, including day-to-day operation of the SCIF. Program shall focus on planning, security integration, ITAR controls, physical security controls, database management, classified processing, communications security and security of information technology systems."

7.7.1 The Contractor shall perform program security functions at Michoud Assembly Facility, New Orleans, LA. The Contractor shall assist and advise in the following facets of security to include physical, operational, and personnel security. The Contractor shall assist and advise in the following: investigations, access control, visitor processing, key and lock control, review and distribution of incident reports, presentation of security briefings, preparation of security related reports, response to security questions and queries from employees and the public, compilation and preparation of statistical data related to security issues or concerns, preparation of security announcements to the public, updating security program information and procedures. The Contractor shall attend meetings as a representative of the Protective Services Office, conduct physical security audits and vulnerability assessments, and perform liaison with other security and law enforcement professionals. The Contractor's duties shall not exceed 24 hours per week.

7.7.2 Perform program security management functions at Michoud Assembly Facility, New Orleans, LA. Incumbent will work independently assisting and advising in all facets of security including physical security, operational security, personnel security, investigations, access control, visitor processing, key and lock control, review and distribution of incident reports, presentation of security briefings, preparation of security related reports, response to security questions and queries from employees and the public, compilation and preparation of statistical data related to security issues or concerns, preparation of security announcements to the public, updating security program information and procedures, attending meetings as a representative of the Protective Services Office, conducting physical security audits and vulnerability assessments, and performing liaison with other security and law enforcement professionals. Duties will not exceed 40 hours per week.

8.0 Physical Qualifications

8.1 Each security officer shall be in good physical condition; be capable of standing, or walking for an entire shift, being outside in severe weather conditions and carrying objects weighing up to 50 pounds; be able to protect themselves and others; and withstand sudden emotional stress and physical exertion in apprehension of suspects and violators. Pursuit may be on foot, requiring running, jumping, climbing, and/or crawling, followed by physical contact to overpower the violator as necessary.

8.2 All security officers, dispatchers, and uniformed supervisors shall meet the physical qualifications as set forth in the Civil Service Handbook X-118, Section G.5., "Qualifications Standards for Guards and Guard Supervisors, Series 085," on an annual basis, with the following additional requirements/modifications:

8.3 Vital Capacity: Demonstrate adequate pulmonary function by passing pulmonary function test of 85% predicted Forced Vital Capacity (FVC) and 86% Forced Expiratory Volume (FEV1) of measured FVC.
