

**AMENDMENT OF SOLICITATION/MODIFICATION OF CONTRACT
(continued)**

The purposes of this modification are to (A) definitize the Contractor's proposal SAIC-P-010, entitled "Marshall Space Flight Center (MSFC) Agencywide Information Services Wide Area Network (WAN) Replacement Project" dated July 28, 2005 (this proposal was submitted in response to NASA/MSFC letter request for proposal PS31-J/AA02C-05-138 dated July 1, 2005), (B) delete the requirement for submission of the Information Resources Strategic/Implementation Plans, and (C) revise Clause H.11 to delineate the Limitation of Contracting clause. Accordingly, NNM04AA02C is modified as follows:

- A. Under Section B, Clause B.2, Estimated Cost and Award Fee, the total of Estimated Cost and Potential Award Fee is increased by \$1,050,998. This increase is by \$991,507 (from \$483,672,138 to \$484,663,645) for Estimated Cost and by \$59,491 (from \$15,681,548 to \$15,741,039) for Potential Award Fee and is for the base period only as reflected in paragraph (a), CLIN 001. These amounts are further allocated by contract year as follows:

- B. Clause H.11, Applicability of Section Clauses to Subcontracts, is revised to reference clause H.3, Limitation of Future Contracting (NFS 1852.209-71), in order to ensure the appropriate flowdown of this clause.
- C. Attachment J-2, Data Procurement Document, Data Requirements Description 974MA-007, Documentation, is revised in order to reflect the deletion of the Information Resources Strategic/Implementation Plans as the contents of these documents are included in the Five Year Integrated Information Technology Plan, also delineated in DRD 974MA-007.
- D. Attachment J-7, Small Business Subcontracting Plan, is amended to include the subcontracting plan supplement required by definitization of the proposal referenced in A. above, for the "Marshall Space Flight Center (MSFC) Agencywide Information Services Wide Area Network (WAN) Replacement Project." This plan will not be numbered but will be incorporated as a supplement to Attachment J-7. Future

subcontracting plan supplements will also be incorporated as part of this attachment. It is noted that the cumulative contract value associated with this plan supplement, and future plan supplements, will include contract value increases that fell below the threshold requiring submission of a small business subcontracting plan supplement, if applicable. Therefore, the cumulative value page of each supplement will also reflect definitization of any of these proposals.

- E. On the Standard Form 26, Award/Contract, Block 15G, the total contract value is increased by \$1,050,998 (from \$511,811,640 to \$512,862,638) in recognition of the actions taken in (A) above.
- F. The modification(s) made above are reflected in total on the change page(s) enclosed herewith. In order to reflect the change(s) made, the page(s) listed below are hereby deleted from, or added to, NNM04AA02C. Either bolded text or a vertical change bar included in the right margin indicates the specific area(s) of change.
