Dear Mr. Elliott,

I am the co-chair public safety of the Woodland Hills Warner Center Neighborhood Council committee and area 2 board member. I am very concerned about the proposed clean up at the NASA site in the Santa Susana Pass. I understand there could be up to 200,000 truck trips between all parties involved in this process. What would be the environmental impact of this? I am also concerned about transporting contaminated soil in open trucks utilizing only tarps to contain to contaminated soil.

What would happen in the event of an accident with these trucks? Is there a cleanup plan for this and what are the dangers of having these contaminants air born either from an accident or just blowing out of the trucks during normal operation?

I would like to see cleanup levels changed to residential standard. If cleanup is absolutely necessary, however in my opinion there will be more negative impact in doing cleanup rather than just keeping things the way they are.

There will also be negative impact on plant and wildlife in the area. If this over the top cleanup takes place, this whole project as it stands just seems bad for the community at large. I hope some form of alternate planning can be considered.
