RE: Comment on the NASA DEIS


Dear Mr. Elliott:

The DEIS addresses the sites available to receive the contaminated soil removed from the 100+ acres of land at the Santa Susana Field Laboratory, but it fails to mention where the soil will be found to replace it. From my reading of the document, about the removed soil will be replaced by “clean” soil of approximately 1/3 of the amount removed.

Where are you going to obtain that amount of soil that is compatible with this area ? It will have to meet the DTSC standards (Lookup Tables) and be of similar components to allow the natural plants of this area to regrow.

The EIS should be rewritten to examine and show the decision makers and the public the full story, not just the parts the politicians want us to see.
